Remember that Worley Ave is a ONE WAY SCHOOL ZONE during arrival and dismissal. You should always be driving to where

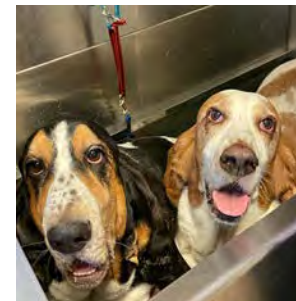

CODE OF BEHAVIORAL CONDUCT
