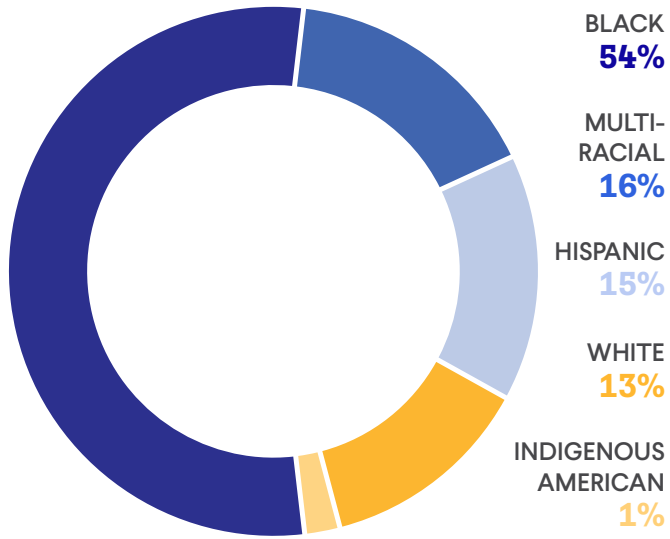

## STUDENT DEMOGRAPHICS

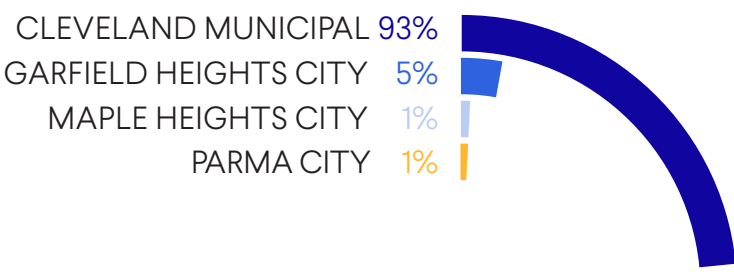

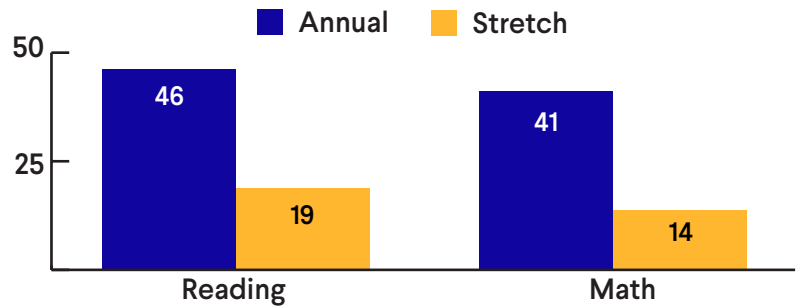
