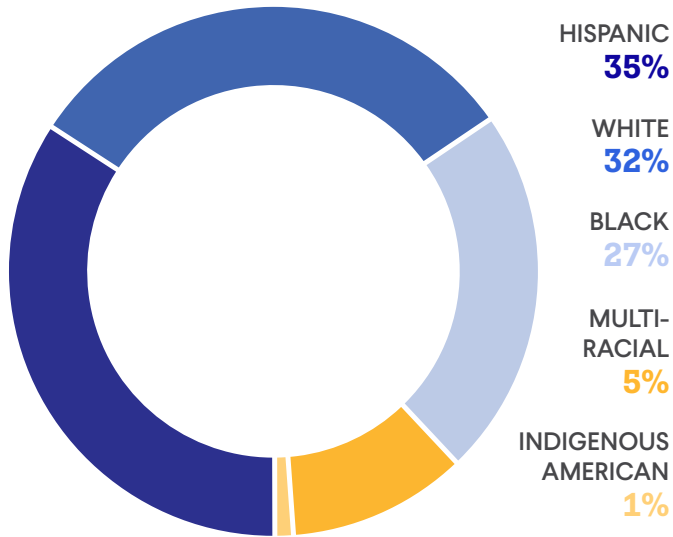

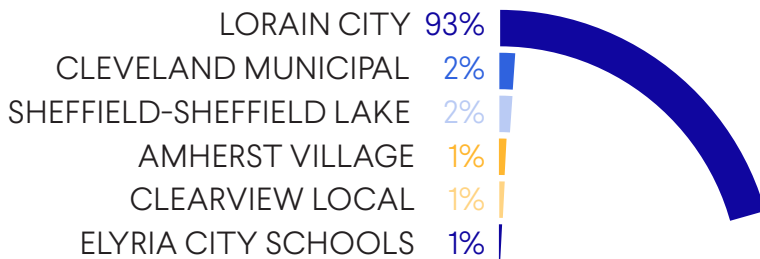

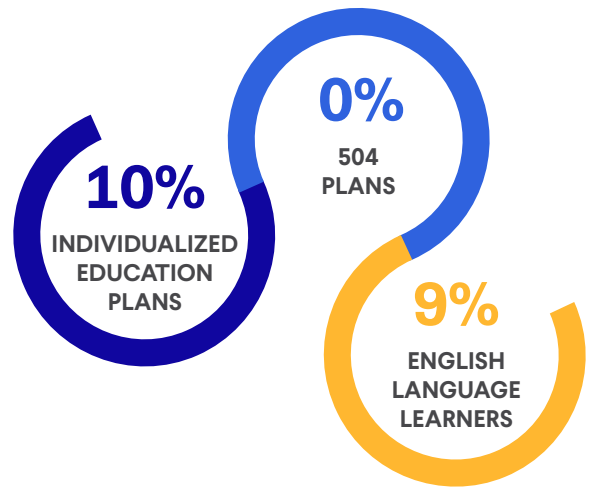
DISTRICTS OF RESIDENCE

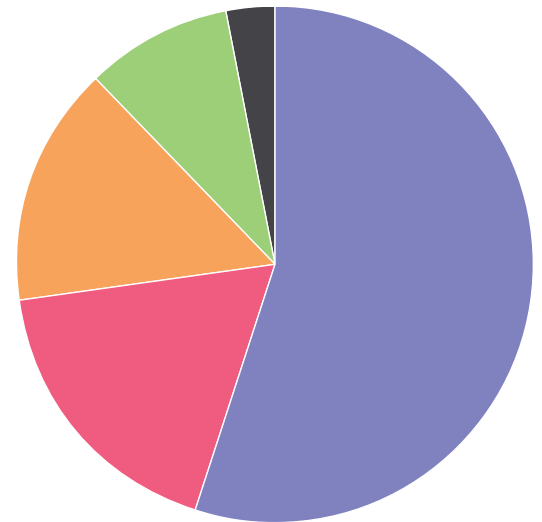

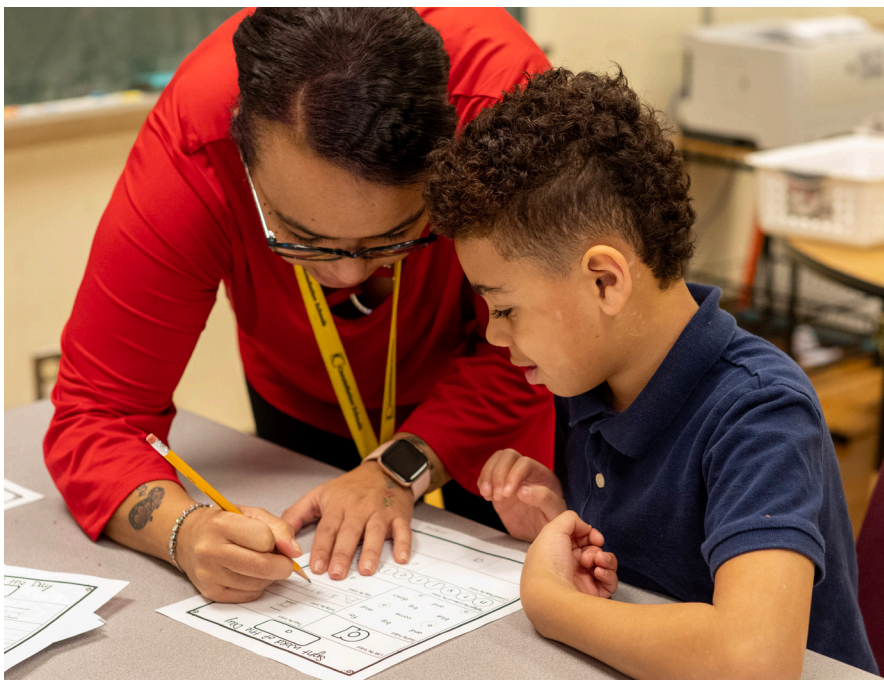
