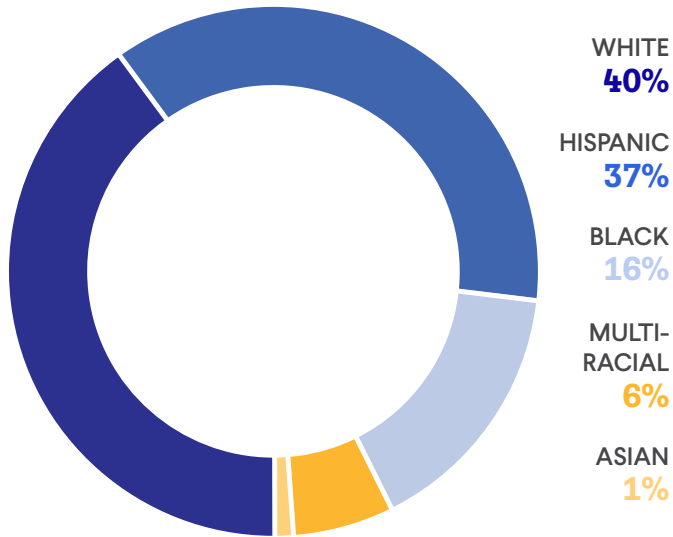

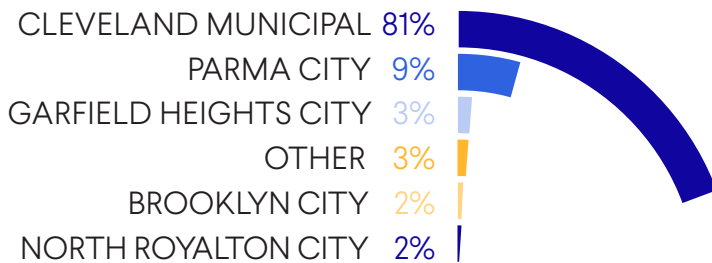

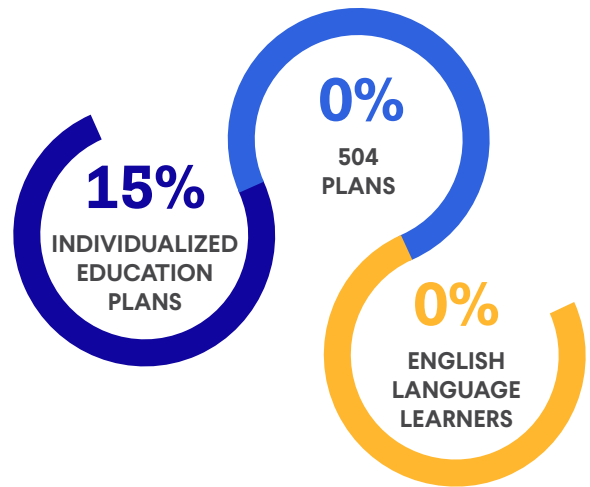
DISTRICTS OF RESIDENCE

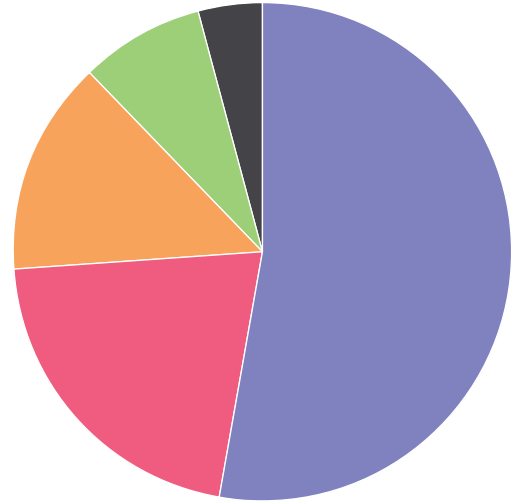
