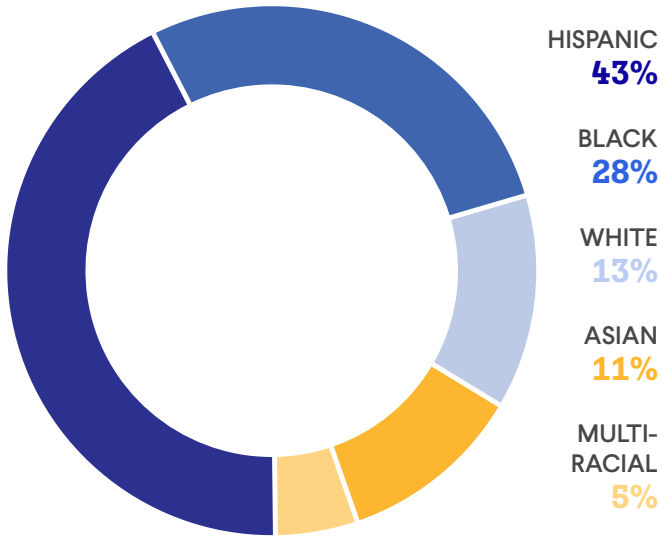

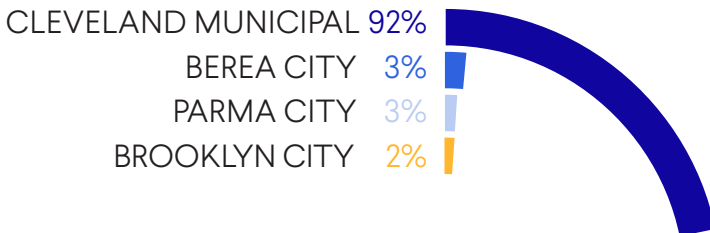

DISTRICTS OF RESIDENCE

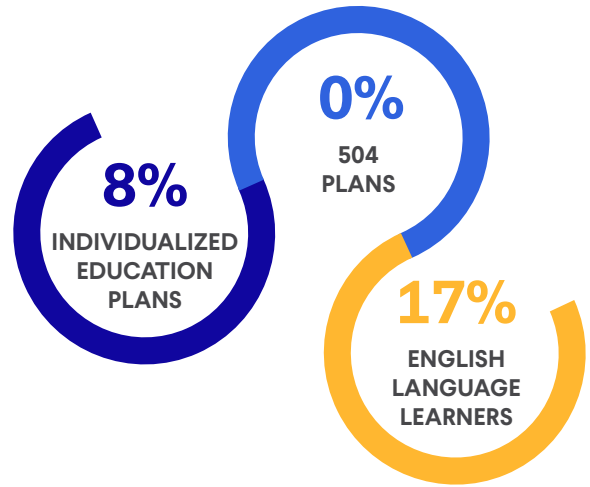

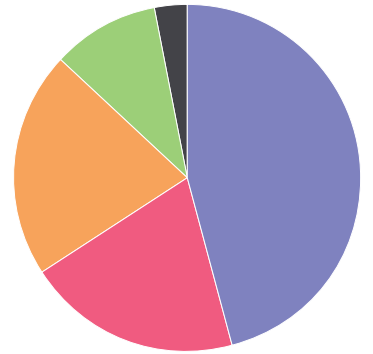

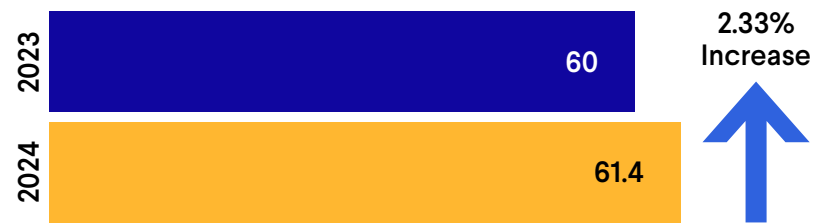


ACHIEVEMENT BY PERFORMANCE LEVEL
