Students arriving after 8:15am must sign in at the main office and receive an office pass before going to class.

Dismissal Procedures:

All students are dismissed at the back school doors. All parents will enter from West 67th Street and exit from West 65th Street. No early dismissal will be allowed without the office being notified by 12:00 pm. Students will be dismissed by an identified number which will be displayed to a staff member. Parents will receive this number before the school year starts.

Dismissal for walkers starts at 3:20 pm. Dismissal for all other students starts at 3:23 pm. If there is any change in your child's transportation schedule, please submit it in written form so we can adjust it accordingly.
