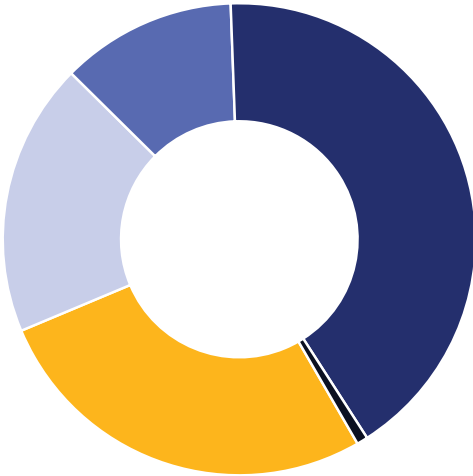

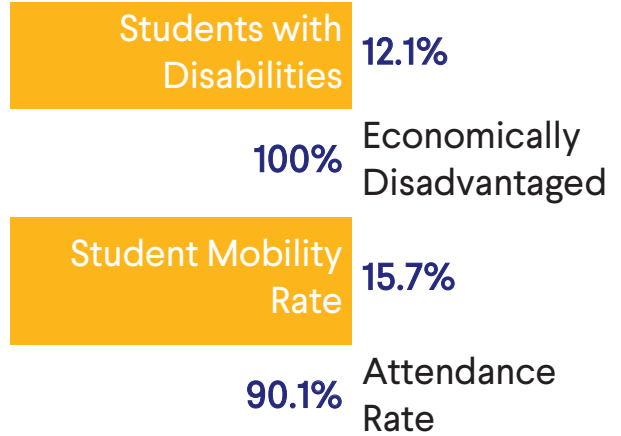

Progress towards Goals

The percent proficient in ELA on the state assessment decreased from 42.6% in SY2024 to 37.5% in SY2025.

The percent proficient in Math on the state assessment decreased from 36% in SY2024 to 33.5% in SY2025.

Discipline occurrences decreased by 28% from SY2024 to SY2025.

#1 By FY2028, the overall percentage of students reaching proficiency or above on state tests in English Language Arts and Mathematics will increase by 30%.

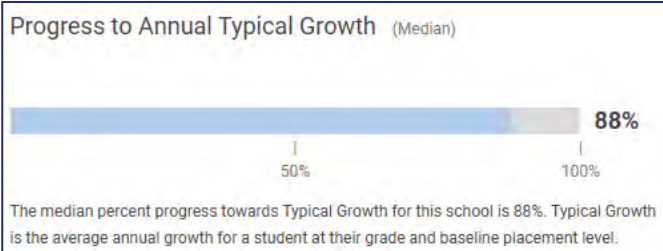

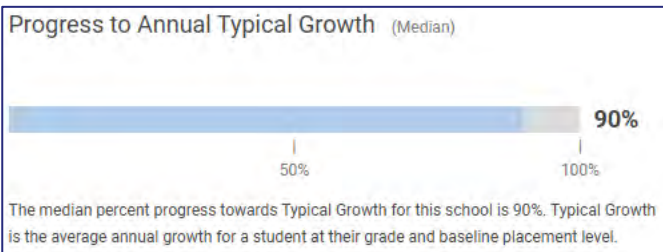


Constellation Schools Elyria Community

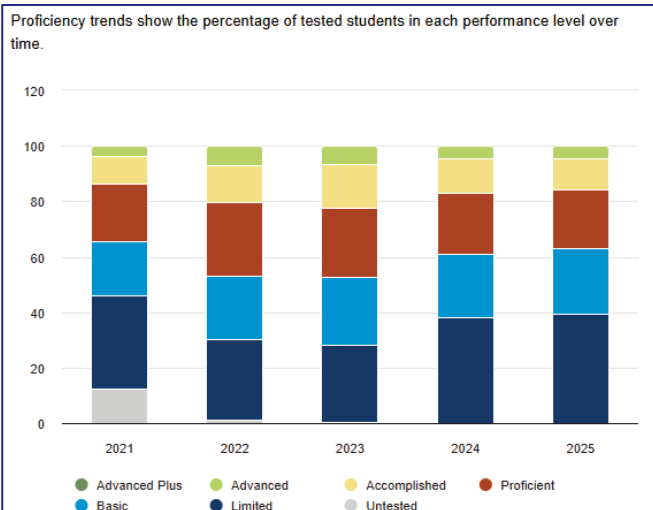
iReady Reading

OUR HIGHLIGHTS
