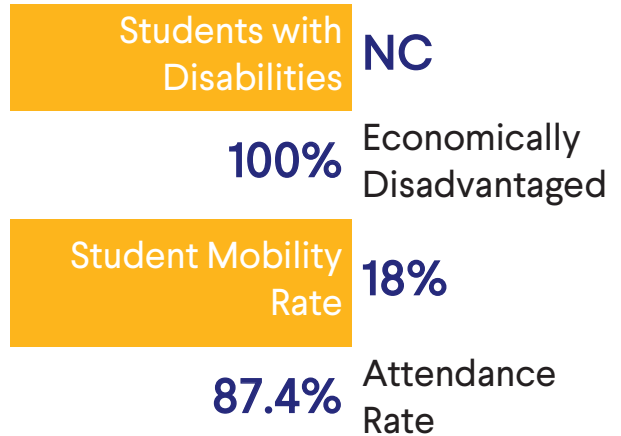

## Progress towards Goals

The percent proficient in ELA on the state assessment decreased from 28.2% in SY2024 to 11.5% in SY2025.

The percent proficient in Math on the state assessment decreased from 30.8% in SY2024 to 7.7% in SY2025.

Discipline occurrences remained extremely low and constant from SY2024 to SY2025.

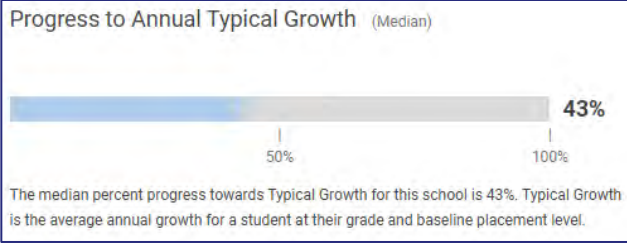

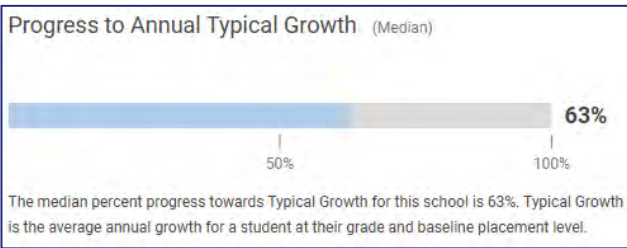

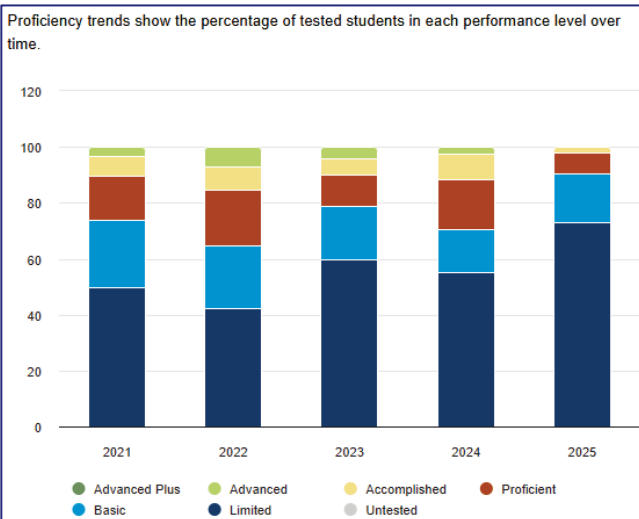
## iReady Reading
