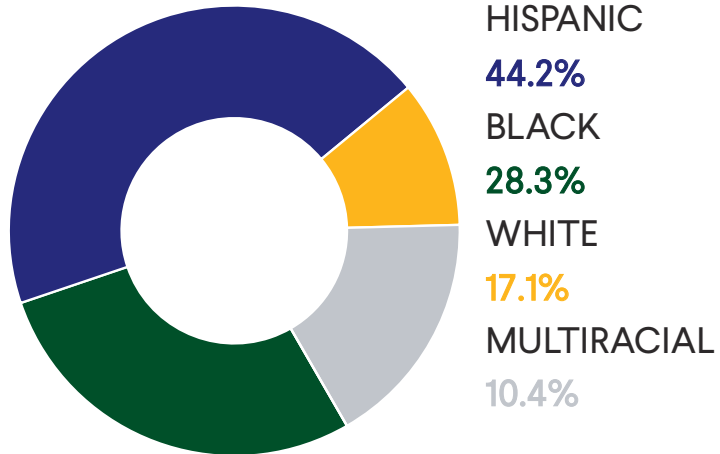

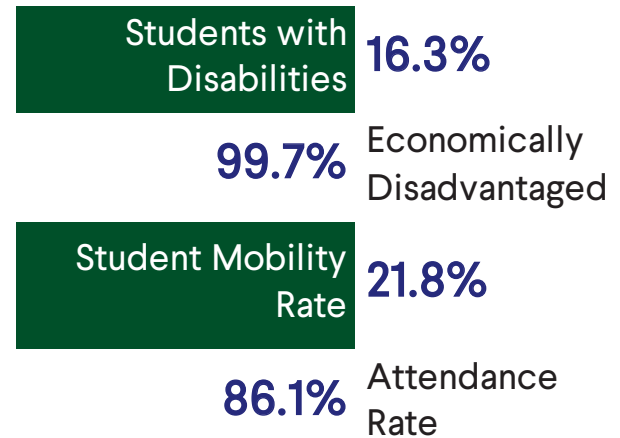

Progress towards Goals

The percent proficient in ELA on the state assessment decreased from 18% in SY2024 to 17.3% in SY2025.

The percent proficient in Math on the state assessment decreased from 7.2% in SY2024 to 10.9% in SY2025.

Discipline occurrences from SY2024 to SY2025 remained constant.

Our Academic Goals

#1 By FY2028, the overall percentage of students reaching proficiency or above on state tests in English Language Arts and Mathematics will increase by 30%.

#2 By FY2028, the performance of students will improve by decreasing the discipline occurrences by 15%.

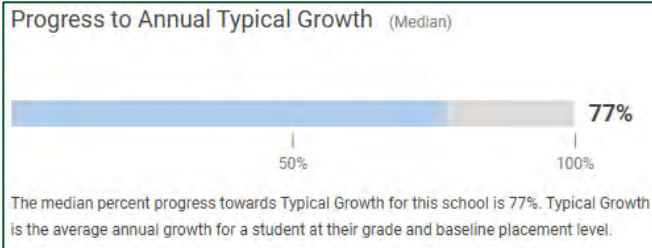

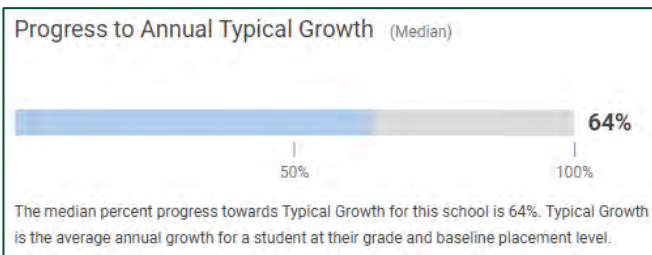

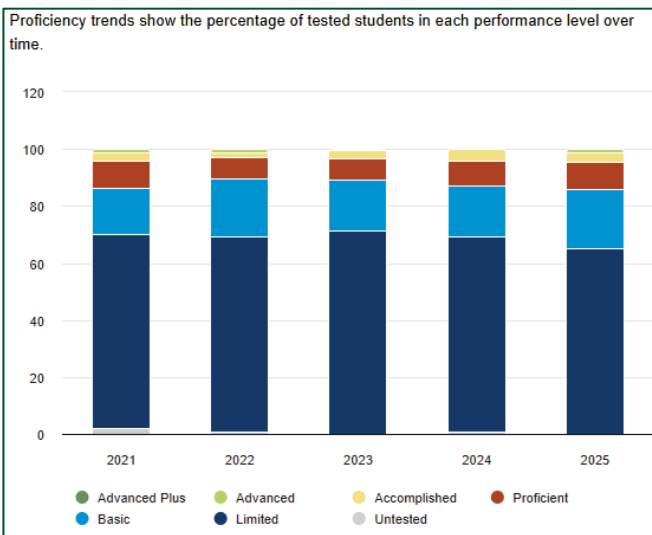
iReady Reading
