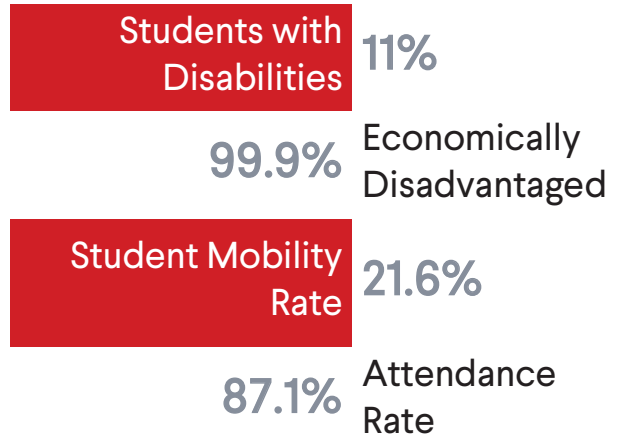

## Progress towards Goals

The percent proficient in ELA on the state assessment decreased from 34% to 21.1% from SY2024 to SY2025.

The percent proficient in Math on the state assessment decreased from 27.2% to 25.2% SY2024 to SY2025.

Suspension occurrences from SY2024 to SY2025 decreased by 68%.

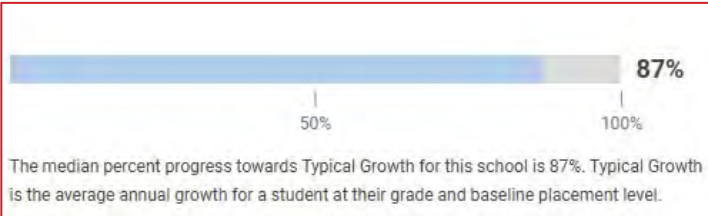

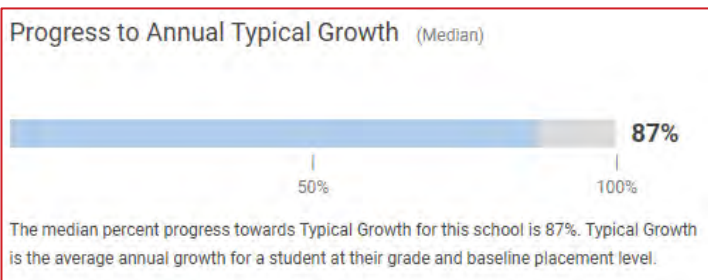

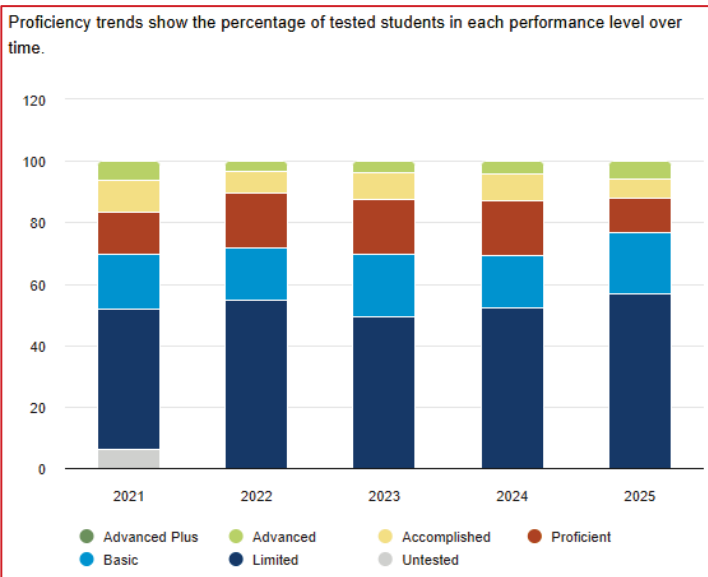
## iReady Reading
