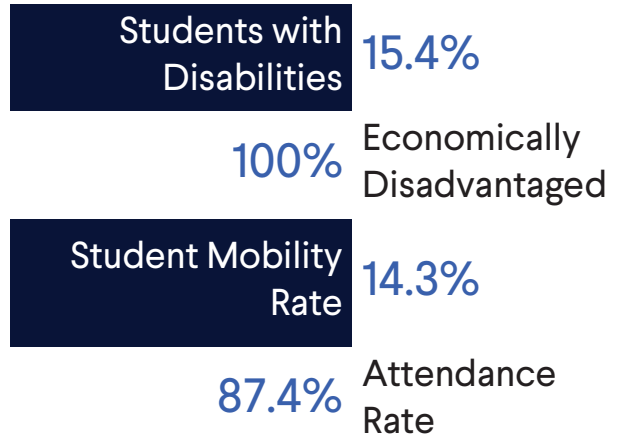
Student Demographics

The percent proficient in Math on the state assessment decreased from 43.2% to 32.5% from SY2024 to SY2025.

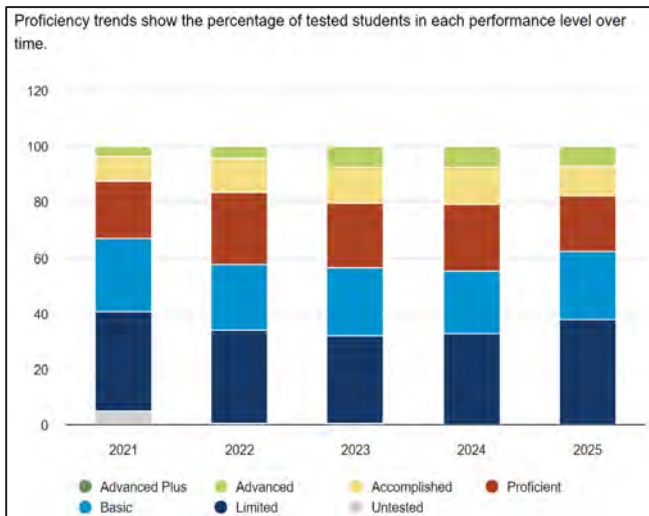

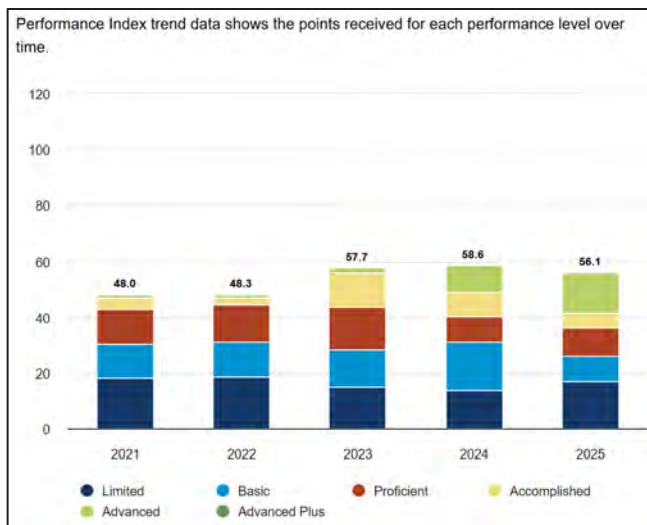


Constellation Schools Parma Community
