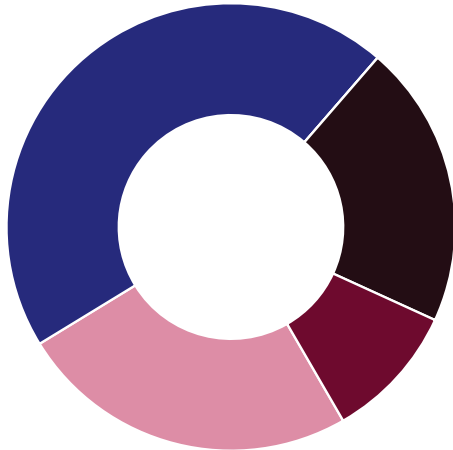

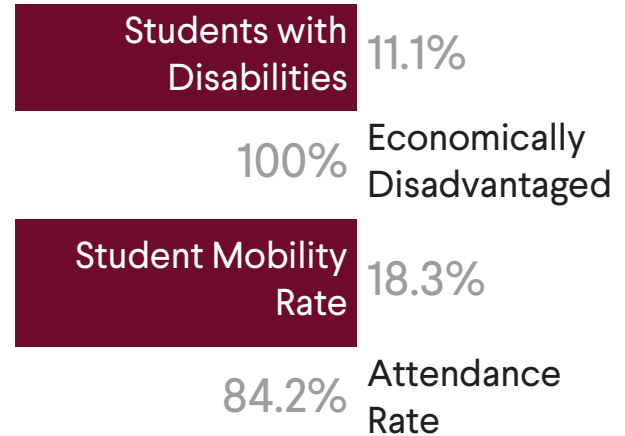
## Student Demographics

## Progress towards Goals

The percent proficient in ELA on the state assessment decreased from 39.7% in SY2024 to 28.8% in SY2025.

The percent proficient in Math on the state assessment decreased from 17.2% in SY2024 to 10.6% in SY2025.

Discipline occurrences from SY2024 to SY2025 remained at the same low level.

## Our Academic Goals

**#1** By FY2028, the overall percentage of students reaching proficiency or above on state tests in English Language Arts and Mathematics will increase by 30%.

**#2** By June 2028, the performance of students will improve by decreasing the discipline occurrences by 15%.

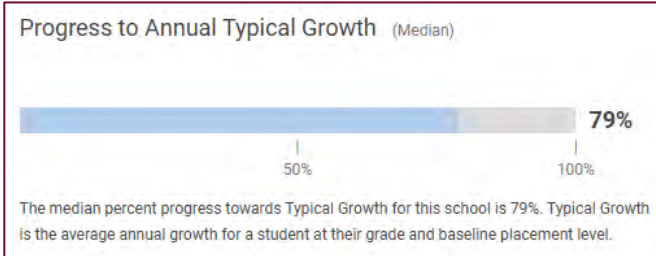

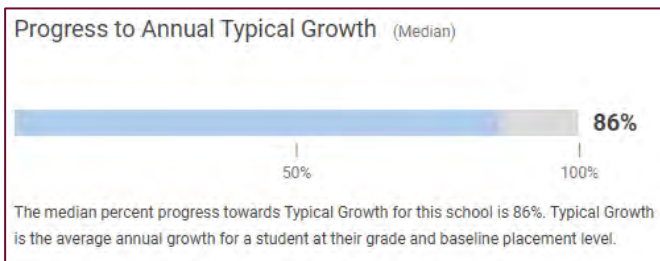

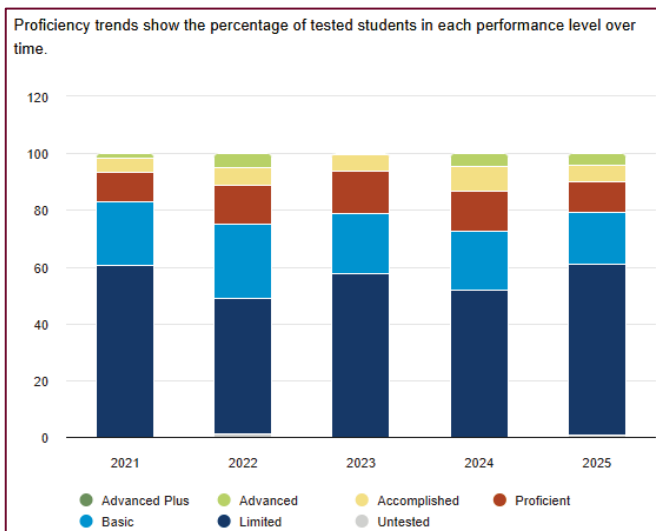
