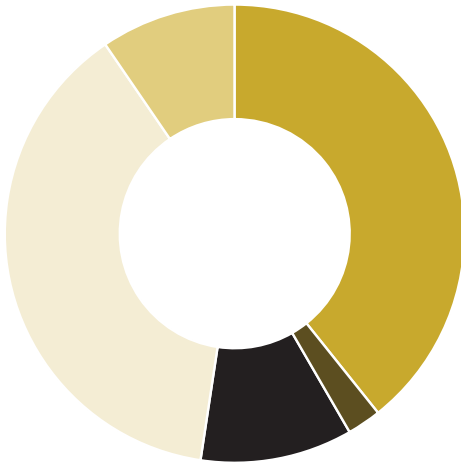

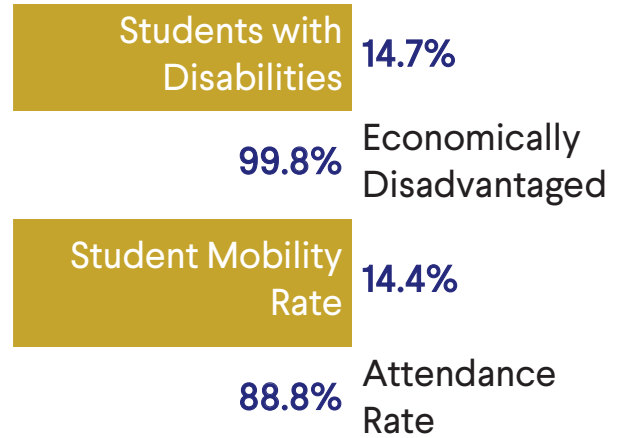

The percent proficient in Math on the state assessment decreased from 35.3% in SY2024 to 40.6% in SY2025.

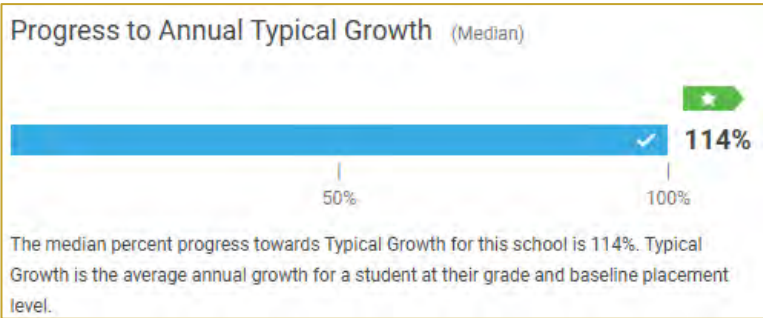

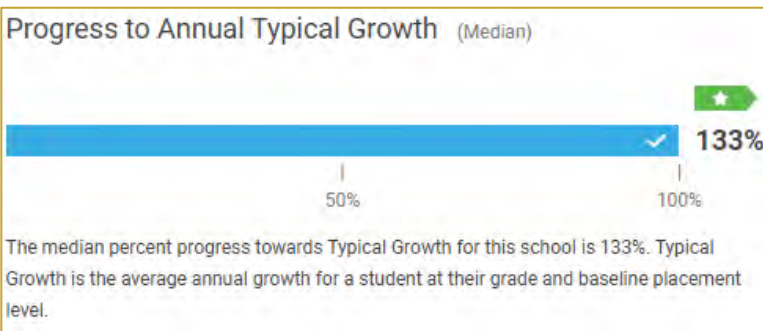

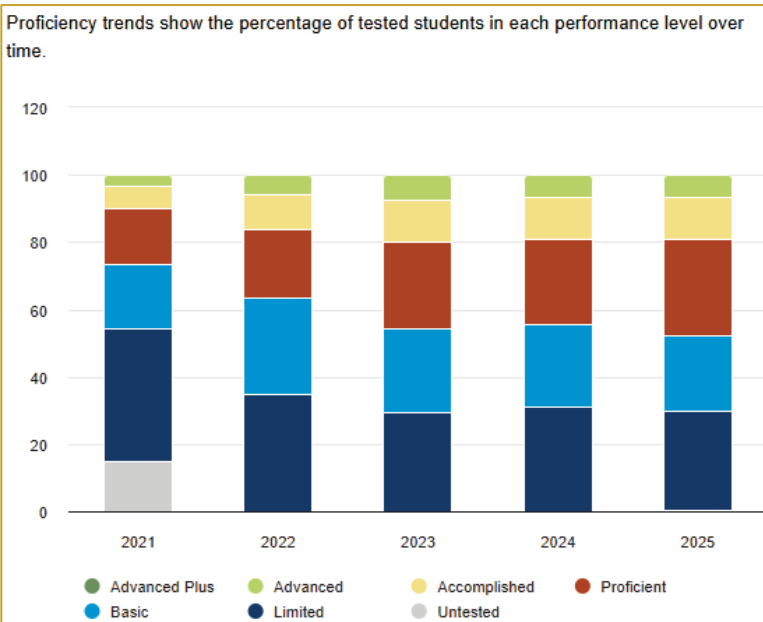
iReady Reading
